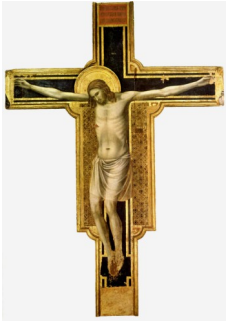

At St. Rose of Lima School the most important thing that we do is to provide your child with a quality Catholic education.

Each child is formed in the faith that we, the Church, have received from Jesus Christ through his Apostles

Here at our school, your child will be formed in the rich tradition of the Catholic faith through prayer, classroom instruction, Mass and the sacraments, and service.

Prayer

We begin each day by thanking God for the many gifts and graces he has given us and by asking him to bless those we love, those who have asked for or need our



We also provide a number of other opportunities for prayer: celebrations of the feasts of various saints; devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary; blessing of the Advent wreath; Lenten Stations of the Cross, etc.

Classroom Instruction

Each grade level follows an age-appropriate Catholic curriculum. Students learn about the faith we profess in the creed, the faith we celebrate in the Church's liturgy and sacraments, the faith we live by following the Ten Commandments and the moral teachings of the Church, and the faith we experience in a vital and personal relationship with the living God through prayer. Both their classroom teachers and our parish priests—Msgr. Kennedy and Fr. Seibt—serve as their instructors in the faith.

Mass and the Sacraments

St. Leo the Great said that everything Christ accomplished to save us has passed over to the sacraments.



Both Christ and we, the Church, act in them to experience the gift of salvation that God has and continues to offer to us. When we celebrate the Eucharist, we proclaim the death and resurrection of the Lord until he comes again.

Therefore, the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, are at the heart of everything we do at St. Rose of Lima to form your child in the faith. Monthly school Masses are celebrated and different classes take turns serving, reading, and singing at the liturgy.

Service

Students at St. Rose of Lima do not simply learn about their faith, they also put it into practice. A number of service projects are offered throughout



the year for students to bring the love of Jesus Christ to all those who are in need. Some of our projects include: collecting food and money for members of our North Syracuse community and singing Christmas carols to the elderly at P.A.C.E.
