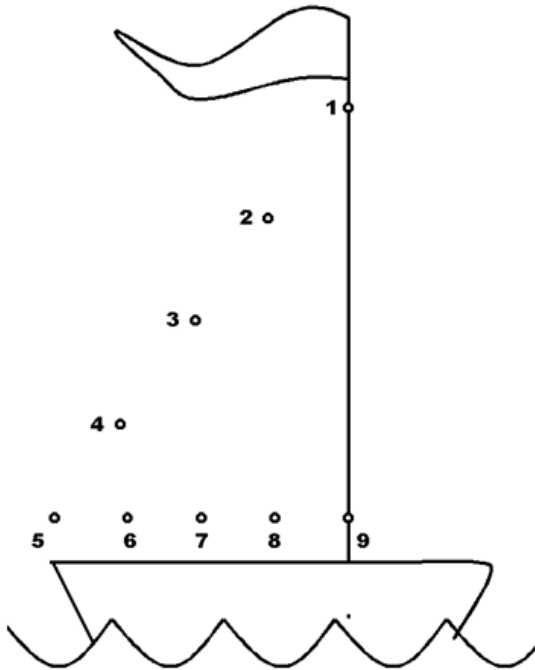


Academic Achievement
