The price for a student's lunch is \$2.35. I strongly encourage parents to prepay using checks rather than cash. You can prepay in advance as long as it is in \$2.35 increments. This does not mean your child has to purchase lunch every day. I will keep track on a daily basis. Checks should be made out to " St. Rose School Lunch" and should include your child's name and room number on the memo line of your check. If you send cash please include your child's name and room number on the envelope. Please send a note to the cafeteria if you allow your child to purchase snacks or ice cream from their prepaid account.

You can still apply for The Free and Reduced Lunch Program if you already haven't done so. Also, if your family income changes at anytime during the year you could be eligible. Applications are always at the main office.

Parents are always welcome to come and have lunch with their child. This month we will be inviting our Mrs. Sees Pre-K class parents on Wednesday, May 8th at 10:45am and on Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10:45am we are inviting Mrs. Dodge Pre-K class parents.
